Drugs and Alcohol - growing concerns

Since the year 2000 there has been an enormous increase in drug overdoses. In the USA in 2016, more than 60,000 individuals died from overdoses in that year alone.

Alcohol also has a higher rate of deaths since 2000 - tis now 88,000 deaths per year attributed to the use of alcohol in USA.

Prevention is the best strategy. The family, church, community, government all have their parts to play. Many organisations do many things to help prevent - but the main strategy is sometimes overlooked and that is the POWER OF GOD in the life of an individual. WCTU is programmed to add this component to any prevention strategy. Indeed it is THE most important part of prevention.
